| 0362T          | Exposure behavioral follow-up assessment, includes physician or other QHP direction with interpretation and report, administered by physician or QHP with the assistance of one or more technicians; first 30 minutes of technician(s) time, face-to-face with the patient.   | <b>0362T</b>  | Behavior identification supporting assessment, each 15 minutes of technician's time face-to-face with a patient requiring the following components: 1) administered by the physician or other QHP who is on-site; 2) with the assistance of two or more technicians; 3) for a patient who exhibits destructive behavior; and 4) completed in an environment that is customized to a patient's behavior. | 15 mins |
| 0363T          | Exposure behavioral follow-up assessment, includes physician or other qualified health care professional direction with interpretation and report, administered by physician or other qualified health care professional with the assistance of one or more technicians; each additional 30 minutes of technician(s) time, face-to-face with the patient (List separately in addition to code for primary procedure). |               |   |         |
| 0364T          | Adaptive behavior treatment by protocol, administered by technician, face-to-face with one patient; first 30 minutes of technician time.  | <b>97153</b>  | Adaptive behavior treatment by protocol, administered by technician under the direction of a physician or other QHP, face-to-face with one patient, each 15 minutes.  | 15 mins |
| 0365T          | Adaptive behavior treatment by protocol, administered by technician, face-to-face with one patient; each additional 30 minutes of technician time (List separately in addition to code for primary procedure).  |               |   |         |
| 0366T          | Group adaptive behavior treatment by protocol, administered by technician, face-to-face with two or more patients; first 30 minutes of technician time.   | <b>97154</b>  | Group adaptive behavior treatment by protocol, administered by technician under the direction of a physician or other QHP, face-to-face with 2 or more patients, each 15 minutes.   | 15 mins |
| 0367T          | Group adaptive behavior treatment by protocol, administered by technician, face-to-face with two or more patients; each additional 30 minutes of technician time (List separately in addition to code for primary procedure).   |               |   |         |
| 0368T          | Adaptive behavior treatment with protocol modification administered by physician or other QHP with one patient; first 30 minutes of patient face-to-face time.  | <b>97155</b>  | Adaptive behavior treatment, with protocol modification, administered by physician or other QHP, which includes simultaneous direction of technician, face-to-face with one patient, each 15 minutes.   | 15 mins |

| 0373T           | Exposure adaptive behavior treatment with protocol modification requiring two or more technicians for severe maladaptive behavior(s); first 60 minutes of technicians' time, face-to-face with patient.   | 0373T         | Adaptive behavior treatment with protocol modification, each 15 minutes of technician's time face-to-face with a patient requiring the following components: 1) administered by the physician or other QHP who is on-site; 2) with the assistance of two or more technicians; 3) for a patient who exhibits destructive behavior; and 4) completed in an environment that is customized to a patient's behavior. | 15 mins |
| 0374T           | Exposure adaptive behavior treatment with protocol modification requiring two or more technicians for severe maladaptive behavior(s); each additional 30 minutes of technicians' time, face-to-face with patient (List separately in addition to code for primary procedure). |               |  |         |
